

Registrations vs Attendance 2019-2020




Technology Update


Below is a list of topics we presented this year between January and September. Even if you did not attend, please indicate how relevant they were for your professional role, or the role you aspire to achieve.

This year the pandemic forced us to pivot to virtual meetings. When face-to-face meetings become possible again, how would you like to see IIBA-Kansas City proceed?



Meeting delivery format preference


If we add a live streaming feature to in-person meetings, how would you likely participate?

- I would do both about equally throughout the year if live streaming is offered.


Live Streaming

What changes to our meetings would improve your chances of participating? Select all that apply. 8 responses




What changes might improve participation?


When should we meet?
